



## APULIA

*Obtained by Dr. Somma Stefano from a crossbreed of Emperor x Thompson Seedless.*

**Bud burst period:** early.

**Ripening period:** late.

**Vigor:** very high.

**Real fertility:** 1,4.

**Production:** high, 25-35 ton/Ha.

**Detachment index:** 650 g.

**Weight of the cluster:** 900g+

**Weight of the berry:** 6 g.

**Grape seeds:** absent (seedless).

**Sugar content:** 18 (°Brix).

**Total acidity:** 3,8 (g/L).

**PH:** 3,66.

**Vegetation management:** it is necessary to intervene several times on the foliar apparatus due to excessive vigor.

**Affinity with rootstocks:** good with 1103 Paulsen, 775 Paulsen and SO4.

**Storage aptitude:** good.

**Transport resistance:** excellent.

**Ampelographic characteristics:** large, conical, winged cluster. Spheroid-shaped berry, red-violet skin; the pulp is quite juicy and sweet, not colored.

### TRAINING AND PRUNING

**Training system:** the variety is well suited to pergola, with planting layout 2,5x 2,5 m;

**Pruning:** average, 35-40 buds/plant.

**Sensitivity to diseases and adversities:** normal; excellent resistance to cracking.
