



FIAMMETTA

Obtained by Dr. Stefano Somma from a crossbreed of Emperor x Dawn Seedless.

Bud burst period: late.

Ripening period: average.

Vigor: average.

Real fertility: 1,6.

Production: high, 30-35 t/Ha.

Detachment index: 560g.

Weight of the cluster: 800g.

Weight of the berry: 6 g.

Grape seeds: seedless, may have herbaceous rudiments.

Sugar content: 18 (°Brix).

Total acidity: 3,0 (g/L).

PH: 3,70.

Vegetation management : within the norm.

Affinity with rootstocks: good with rootstock 1103Paulsen, SO4 and 140RU.

Storage aptitude: good.

Transport resistance: good.

Ampelographic characteristics: large cluster, loose, conical, with 1-2 wings. Medium-sized berry, with a short and uniform elliptical shape. Bright and uniform red skin, thin and resistant. Firm pulp, with a sweet and pleasant taste.

TRAINING AND PRUNING

Training system: the variety adapts well to the pergola, with a planting layout of 2.5 x 2.5 m.

Pruning: medium length, 10 buds per fruiting cane, 40 buds/plant.

Sensitivity to diseases and adversities: within the norm.
